

Call for Nominations: Hydrologic Sciences Award

The Hydrologic Sciences Award is given annually to a hydrologist in recognition of truly outstanding scientific contributions over an entire career, with an emphasis on contributions over the past 5 years. This is one of the highest awards given to hydrologists. Nominations are solicited across all areas of the hydrologic sciences.

Nomination packages for the Hydrologic Sciences Award should include the nominee's curriculum vitae, a nomination letter stating how the nominee meets the selection criteria, and up to three additional supporting letters. The nominating and supporting letters should not exceed two pages in length each. Nomination packages should be sent to the Hydrologic Sciences Award Committee Chair, Michael Celia (celia@princeton.edu). Deadline for receipt of complete nomination packages is **June 1, 2012**.
